Languore Spumante

Light straw in colour, with a beautiful creamy mousse and a perfumed fruity aroma with hints of citrus, peach and apple and floral notes of white flowers. With its soft and creamy taste, blends into the mouth thanks to the good relationship between effervescence, acidity and sweetness.

Veuve Cliquot Brut

A classic benchmark of wines from the region of Champagne. Rich. Ripe. Citrusy in character. This is aged for twice the legally required time to give more complexity and flavour

Balade Romantique Rosé

Provence-style rosé at a snip of the usual asking price. Bursting with aromas of stone fruit, raspberry, strawberry and white flowers, and a stroke of acidity on the finish.

Minuty 'M de Minuty' Rosé

Thirty years ago, Minuty started making a new style of rose, based on freshness above all else. These pale wines became the benchmark for today's most popular style of rose - refreshingly crisp and delicate Provence pink. And Minuty is still the gold standard. Not only are they one of the very last wineries in Provence to pick their grapes by hand, they're also one of only 18 to be designated Cru Classe - the best of the best.

Kokako Sauvignon Blanc

In New Zealand, Captain Cook remarked that the dawn chorus was the most melodious he'd heard. The Kokako bird song in particular sounds like finely tuned bells, their euphonious song carrying miles across the vineyards. With tropical fruit, passion fruit and citrus, this is a typical Kiwi Sauvignon with a bright, clean finish. A perfect accompaniment to seafood and salads.

Le Colline Di San Giorgio Pinot Grigio

A very classic Pinot Grigio with notes of nuts, pear, melon and even a hint of banana. This is beautifully balanced with fresh citrus acidity and a nutty finish.

Beauté du Sud Malbec

Beauté du Sud is an exclusive single variety selection produced from the high quality, distinctive Malbec grape, carefully nurtured in the warm winelands of Southern France. Rich, dark fruit and a rounded, intense palate profile add up to an impressive taste experience.

Le Colline Di San Giorgio Pinot Noir

A characterful Northern Italian Pinot Nero with impressive depth and vibrant personality. Bursting with dark berries, sour cherry, plum, and subtle spice, it also reveals hints of earthiness and jammy richness. Its bold fruit, gentle tannins, and refreshing acidity make it an excellent food companion. Lighter vintages offer lively red fruit and finesse, while decanting enhances its structure and complexity.
